Grand Ledge Building Official Receives State Appointment

GRAND LEDGE, MI, August 12, 2016 — Grand Ledge Building Official, Edward (Scott) Weaver was appointed by Governor Rick Snyder to serve on the State of Michigan’s Electrical Administrative Board. Mr. Weaver currently serves as the Building Official for the City of Grand Ledge. “Edward [has] many years in electrical work and I thank [him] for [his] commitment to serve,” Governor Snyder said.

Housed within the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, the Electrical Administrative Board is responsible for licensing and certifying qualified applicants and developing rules and regulations necessary for enforcing safe electrical practices. Members serve four-year terms, with Mr. Weaver’s term expiring August 10, 2020. Their appointments are subject to the advice and consent of the Senate. “We are proud of Scott and applaud this recognition for his high quality of work and professionalism,” said Adam Smith, City Administrator for the City of Grand Ledge.



Mr. Weaver began his municipal services career in 1999 as an Electrical Inspector for the City of Grand Ledge and transitioned to the Building Official in 2011, a position he continues to hold. In addition, Mr. Weaver has served as the Electrical Inspector for the City of East Lansing since 2007. Mr. Weaver hold licenses and/or certificates in numerous areas, including; Code Official, Master Electrician, Electrical Contractor, Building Contractor, and ICC Residential Electrical Inspector.

The Grand Ledge Building Department operates with three part-time staff, including the Building Official and handles all building, electrical, mechanical, and plumbing permit applications for properties within the City of Grand Ledge. The Building Department is located at 310 Greenwood Street in City Hall and has office hours of 8:00am – 12:00pm on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
