

Effective January 1, 2018 use of the Compost Center is limited to City of Grand Ledge residents only.

Annual passes will only be available for purchase at City Hall (cash or check), and are no longer being sold on site at the compost center.



Why is the compost center limited to only City of Grand Ledge residents now?

It has been conveyed to the City of Grand Ledge by Oneida Township officials that they will no longer be financially supporting the composting program and as a result are choosing not to collaborate with the City of Grand Ledge in providing composting services to city and township residents. Due to this decrease in funding to support operating costs, the compost center will only be open to City of Grand Ledge residents effective January 1, 2018.
