

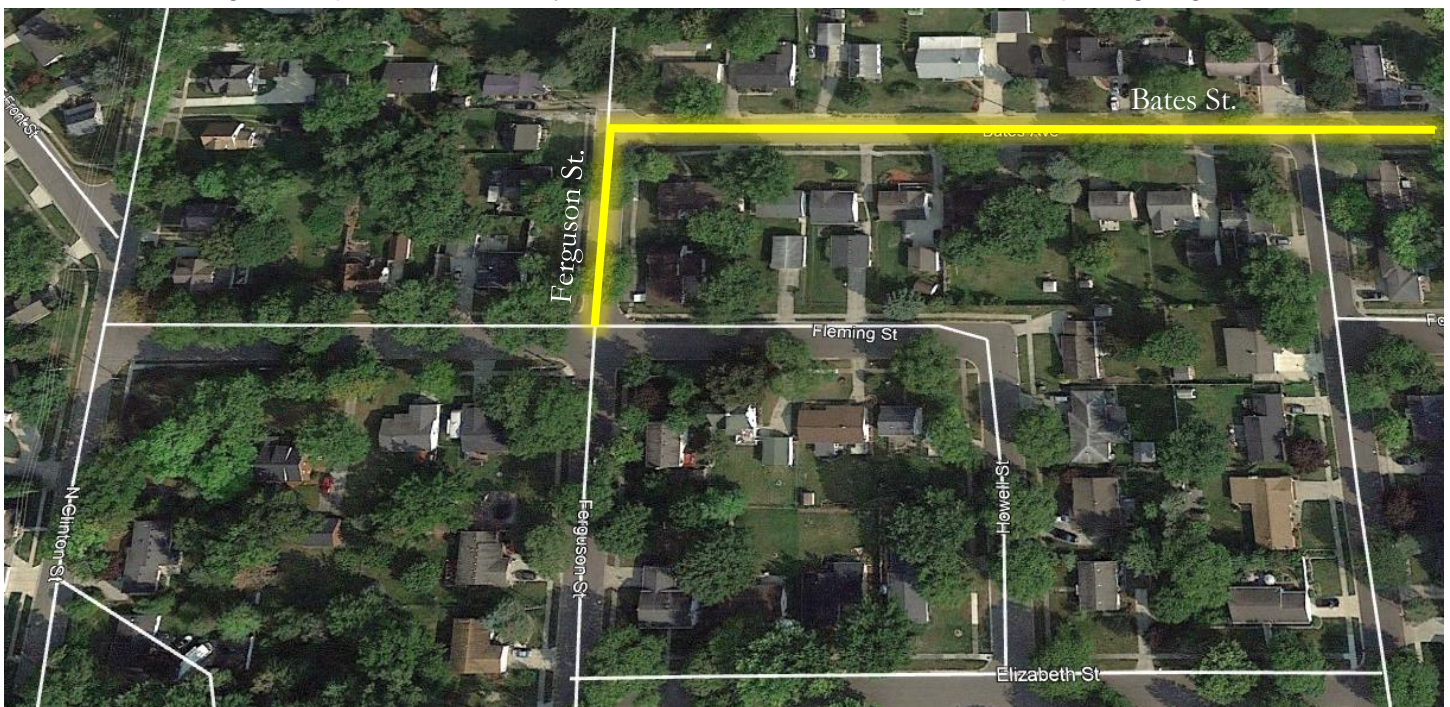

RE: IMPORTANT NOTICE OF BATES/FERGUSON STREET RESURFACING PROJECT

On Friday, July 27, 2018, resurfacing on Bates/Ferguson Streets, is tentatively scheduled to begin. On that day the existing pavement will be milled to a depth of 1 ½". Residents within the project area will not be able to access their driveways once the milling begins. **If you live in the noted sections on Bates or Ferguson (highlighted area on the map) please avoid using your driveway or parking on the street during this time.** Once milling is complete, all driveways and the road will be accessible until paving begins.



During the paving process, **the noted sections on Bates and Ferguson will be closed to ALL traffic. Residents in the noted sections will not have access to their driveways.** Residents can find construction updated online at www.cityofgrandledge.com > Residents > Construction & Project Updates.

How do I arrive at and leave my home on Bates or Ferguson during the paving process?

During paving, residents will NOT have access to the noted sections of Bates or Ferguson between 8:30am – 4:00pm. Please plan ahead and move your vehicle to one of the adjacent streets *before* 8:00am. Any vehicle on your property after 8:30am cannot be moved until 4:00pm that afternoon, or when paving is complete and traffic is allowed on the road. On-street, overnight parking will be permitted on adjacent streets during the construction period.

Why is the schedule ‘tentative’?

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. The City will provide updates via, www.cityofgrandledge.com and residents can also call the Public Service Department, Monday – Friday between 8:00am – 5:00pm at 517-627-2149.
