General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the plumbing code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection call the above number providing as much advanced notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A permit will be canceled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection.

PLAN REVIEW REQUIRED

Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. One-family and two-family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 ft² of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Assembly, business, mercantile, and storage buildings with a required plumbing fixture count of less than twelve.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.

If plans are required, plans must be submitted before a permit will be issued.
