

Parking Violations

1. Parking too far from curb
2. Angle parking violations
3. Obstructing traffic
4. Prohibited parking (signs unnecessary, except as indicated):
 - a. On sidewalk
 - b. In front of drive
 - c. Within intersection
 - d. Within 15 feet of a hydrant
 - e. On crosswalk
 - f. Within 20 feet of crosswalk or 15 feet of corner lot lines
 - g. Within 30 feet of street signs, traffic sign or signal
 - h. Within 50 feet of railroad crossing
 - i. Within 210 feet of fire station entrance
 - j. Within 75 feet of fire station entrance on opposite side of street (sign required)
 - k. Beside street excavation when traffic obstructed
 - l. Double Parking
 - m. On bridge or viaduct
 - n. Within 200 feet of accident where police in attendance
 - o. In front of theater
 - p. Blocking emergency exit
 - q. Blocking fire escape
 - r. Wrong direction
 - s. Front yard parking
 - t. Blocking a mailbox
 - u. All night parking in parking lots (3:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.)
5. In prohibited zone (sign required)
6. In an alley
7. Parking for prohibited purpose:
 - a. Displaying vehicle for sale
 - b. Working on or repairing vehicle
 - c. Displaying advertising
 - d. Selling merchandise
 - e. Storage over 48 hours
8. Wrong side, boulevard or roadway
9. Loading zone violation
10. Not parked within parking space
11. Failure to set brakes
12. Parked on grade, wheels not turned to curb
13. Abandoned vehicle (plus towing and storage charges)
14. All night parking on streets (2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.)
15. Between sidewalk and curb
16. Private property without owner's consent
17. Parking in handicapped areas (sign required, towing and storage charges added if towed)
